The WestPlan Public Participation Plan procedure was followed to achieve public participation for this meeting. There were no comments from the public.

IV. TIP AMENDMENTS

Mr. Mulnix spoke on the FY2017-2020 TIP. The committee members received a copy of the proposed Amendment H as follows.

City of Norton Shores

Add Project to FY2017-2020 TIP

FY 2020, Local Bridge- Preventative Maintenance - Lake Harbor Road over Mona Lake Channel. Federal: \$170,000 State: \$0 Local - \$0, Total - \$170,000

City of Muskegon

Advance Construct- year change

MDOT Job Number 130796 –Lakeshore Drive, McCracken to Laketon- listed as an FY2020 (Advance Construct Conversion (ACC)) STUL Project, to be Advance Constructed (AC) in FY2018. This request is to change that Advance Construct year from FY2018 to FY2019. All Federal and match numbers remain as programmed.

Project: Lakeshore Drive from McCracken to Laketon, Reconstruct- Federal: \$800,000 State: \$0 Local: \$1,600,000 Total: \$2,400,000

MCRC

2020 - Trent Road Bridge, \$722,950 Local Bridge, total cost \$761,000.

Giles Road: Advance construct

2018 – Giles Road: Revise project limits in rural section. Was Peterson Road to Buys Road (rural). New limits would be Scenic Drive to Buys Road (rural). Total Project limits are Whitehall Road to Scenic Drive, 5.1 miles. \$200,000 Federal, FY2018 funds and \$1,400,000 local.

2019 – Giles Road Advance Construct conversion: \$600,000 STP-U & \$438,090 STP-R. Project limits are Whitehall Road to Buys Road (urban) and Buys Road to Scenic Drive (Rural). Local funds: \$361,900.

A motion was made to approve the proposed amendment. The motion was approved. M/S Murphy/Farrar

Tyler Kent gave a brief update on the Long Range Transportation Planning process.
