## **ATTACHMENT II**

## FY2019 Unprogrammed funding

During the Jobnet transition it was discovered that there was a balance of STUL funding in the FY2019 program year. The original amount programmed in the current TIP for FY2019 is: **\$2,176,000**. The revised amount to be programmed is: **\$2,477,187**, leaving a balance in FY2019 of **\$301,187**.

This balance can be added to an existing approved project in the TIP, and can be split over several projects, which is what MPO staff is recommending. The following chart shows the FY2019 projects. We have heard from several agencies that are interested in adding the funding to their existing project.

# **ATTACHMENT IV**

MPO Staff has been informed that there is a balance of funding available through the Highway Infrastructure Program (HIP). There is approximately **\$190,341** to be programmed on STP eligible road or bridge projects. This funding can be added to an existing project that has not been obligated yet, or can be used for a new project. The funding must be obligated by September 30, 2021. This item does not need immediate action but the committees will need to decide how to spend it.
