Now open, the addition of the former Nugent Sand property adds miles of trails through forested dunes, an inland lake perfect for kayaking, fishing, and nature viewing just a few blocks away from Norton Shores, Roosevelt Park, and the City of Muskegon. The north lake area of the park is expected to open to the public in early 2023. The acquisition has been made possible by Michigan Department of Natural Resources Trust Fund, the generous past landowner, the Land Conservancy of West Michigan, and the County of Muskegon.
