I. CALL TO ORDER

Chairperson Matt Farrar called the meeting to order at 1:30. Attendance was taken via roll call. A quorum was present.

II. APPROVAL OF PREVIOUS MINUTES

Minutes from the previous meeting were reviewed. A motion was made and supported to approve minutes as presented of the November 5, 2020 Technical Committee meeting. Motion approved. *M/S Bessinger/Koens*

III. PUBLIC COMMENT

The WestPlan Public Participation Plan procedure was followed to achieve public participation for this meeting. There were no comments from the public.

- **II. FY2020-FY2023 TIP Amendment 12:** Mr. Mulnix presented Amendment 12 for the FY 2020-2023 TIP.
 - <u>211144</u>- FY2021- (HSIP) CON Phase Traffic Safety- Region wide- Total Phase Cost \$400,000 MDOT (**ABANDON**)
 - <u>211144</u>- FY2021- (HSIP) PE phase Traffic Safety- Region wide- Total Phase Cost \$5,000 MDOT (**ABANDON**)
 - <u>205891</u>- FY2021- (STL) Whitehall Road, Bard to Michillinda- CPM- Fed: \$599,261 Local: \$149,829 Total: \$764,145 MCRC (SCOPE AND LENGTH CHANGE)
 - <u>211753</u>- FY2022- (TAUL) Construct Grand River Greenway Phase IV Non-motorized pathway- Green Street from 144th to 128th and 128th in Robinson Township- Fed: \$2,337,757 Local: \$1,151,190 Total: \$3,539,190 OCRC- (**ADD NEW PROJECT**)
 - FY2022- (CMAQ) Signal upgrade and interconnect- Henry Street at Summit- Total cost: \$200,000- City of Norton Shores (ADD NEW PROJECT)
 - FY2022- (CMAQ) Remove Signal- Washington at 5th Street Total Cost: \$50,000- City of Grand Haven- (ADD NEW PROJECT)

Mr. Alex Craigmile stated that the City of Norton Shores would like to remove the signal upgrade at Henry and Summit and replace with a new project. Staff noted that they had received a number of walk on requests for January and that due to public involvement requirements changes would need to wait until February.

Dear Metropolitan Planning Organization Director:

The Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) is pleased to provide you with the state targets for the federally required safety performance measures for calendar year 2021. MDOT appreciates the efforts your Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) has made to participate in the coordination process as the safety performance area was discussed through the first half of this calendar year.

State Safety Targets for Calendar Year 2021:

| Safety Performance Measure | Baseline Through Calendar Year 2019 | Calendar Year 2021 State Safety Target |

| Fatalities | 1,004.4 | 968.6 |
| Fatality Rate | 0.998 | 0.982 |
| Serious Injuries | 5,559.6 | 5,533.6 |
| Serious Injury Rate | 5.518 | 5.609 |
| Nonmotorized Fatalities and Serious Injuries | 768.8 | 771.2 |

Federal Law and regulations require that MPOs establish targets not later than 180 days after the State Department of Transportation establishes and reports state safety targets in the State Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) annual report. MDOT submitted Michigan's HSIP annual report on August 31st. MPOs are now required to decide on their MPO safety targets for calendar year 2021 no later than February 27, 2021.

MPOs may support all the state safety targets, establish their own specific numeric targets for all the performance measures, or any combination. MPOs may support the state safety target for one or more individual performance measures and establish specific numeric targets for the other performance measures.
