1. Muskegon County Road Commission/Village of Lakewood Club, chip seal various routes, \$40,602 COVID HIP funding.
2. City of Montague, Old Channel Trail, \$20,301 COVID HIP Small Urban funding, 88,593 MPO COVID HIP funding, \$45,000 local match, \$153,394 total
3. City of Whitehall, Mears Ave., Lake Street - Country Club to White Lake Drive, \$20,301 COVID HIP funding, \$375,000 Small Urban Fed, \$743,200 local match.
