ATTACHMENT III

The Public Participation Plan in Transportation Decision Making

The Public Participation Plan in Transportation Decision Making establishes a framework for the region's stakeholders to influence both long-term transportation policy development and short-term transportation programming. It details the methods and strategies that WestPlan will use to engage a wide range of stakeholders from policymakers to business interests to residents. It also identifies specific ways those stakeholders can connect to the decision-making process for transportation in the MPO. This plan has gone through the federally required 45-day public review period which was from August 23 to October 6, 2021. All public comments received on the plan and the MPO response to those comments are included in Appendix F of the plan.
