- Mr. Luke Walters informed the committee of a grant reward being distributed among two lines in JobNet due to multiple locations. Information on the Wesco on Apple and McCormick on Bard projects are located on the STIP website.
- Mr. Marc Frederickson communicated a lack of news in local MDOT activities, and that autumn will be a slow season for them. They may have an additional project pushed forward from spring for replacement of a culvert along I-96 – more information to follow.
- Mr. John Morrison from West Michigan Trails presented on their new trail wayfinding signs created for the purpose of connectivity, safety, and consistency.
- Mr. Joel Fitzpatrick highlighted Harbor Transit's \$16.2 million grant for EV buses.
